Satellite Accumulation Area

Key Requirements

1. Container Labeling
2. Container Closure
3. Container Condition
4. Container Segregation
5. Secondary Containment
6. No Duplicates
7. SAA Identified
8. Weekly Level I Inspection

1. Containers Labeled:

- 'Hazardous Waste'
- Full chemical names (no abbreviations)
- Hazard box checked (at least one, only those that apply)
- Date when FULL
- Generator/location info

- #### 2. Containers Tightly Closed (funnels latched, quick-connects used)

- #### 3. Containers Compatible with Waste, in Good Shape, Upright, Level, not Tilted, not Stacked

- #### 4. Incompatible Chemicals Segregated (separate secondary containers)

- #### 5. All Containers in Secondary Containment (which can hold entire contents)

- #### 6. Only ONE Container per Waste Stream

- #### 7. Area Identified as an SAA (green sticker)

HAZARDOUS WASTE

SATELLITE ACCUMULATION ONLY
